
Installation DOES require some mechanical skills. A qualified mechanic is always recommended.

Remove front bumper cover. Loosen and remove the injen Evolution intake out of vehicle. Loosen the radiator support. (see inien Evolution instruction sheet EVO2000) Loosen the 2 socket cap screws from bracket and 2 plastic push clips. Push Injen ram scoop down allowing for access to inserts on scoop



Install the rain guard. Secure using provided M6 socket cap screws and tighten. Once secure, cover the socket cap screw using provided vinyl cap. This will prevent any contact with screws and front bumper support. Failure to do so will result in vibration noise.



Rain guard installation is now complete. Re-install the the scoop assembly and secure the intake system. Note: Check clearance and adjust if needed! Failure to check the alignment and adjust the intake can cause damage that will void the warranty. Injen Technology is not responsible for any damages caused by/from improper installation.
