

The age of your exhaust system along with certain engine modifications, such as headers, intake, etc., may also affect its current noise level output.

Please check with your local and state law enforcement agencies for exact regulation requirements.



Remove the stock muffler using 15mm socket and wrench. Remove the hangars from stock isolators. Install the new Injen Axle Back Exhaust. Position the hangars to the stock isolators. Use Provided #63 torsion clamp in the kit. Position for the best to have access to the 17mm nut on clamp. **Do not tighten.** Install the Black tips to the exhaust adjust and fit to desired position and tighten.



Make sure the hangar is installed to the factory isolator. Position for the best fit. Rotate if necessary. Tighten the torsion clamp using 17mm socket and ratchet. Retighten after 50miles and verify the clamp is securred. Congratulations! You have just completed the installation of this intake system. Periodically, check the alignment of the exhaust. Note: Check clearance and adjust if needed! Failure to check the alignment and adjust the exhaust can cause damage that will void the warranty.
