Connecting to the Towtal View HD Camera

1. Download the free Air Lift Towtal View app from the Apple App Store for iOS and from Google Play for Android. Search for Air Lift Towtal View.



2. Power up the Camera Interface, as shown in Figure 2, by plugging the USB-C to a 12v power socket adapter into your vehicle's 12v power socket or built-in USB-C port.

NOTE

Some vehicle's USB ports may not deliver enough power to plug the Camera Interface directly into their USB ports. In these cases, use the 12v power socket adapter.

3. The Camera Interface will now broadcast a Wi-Fi network with a name starting with "Towtal_"
4. Open your device's Wi-Fi settings and connect to the Towtal_##### WiFi network. There is no password.
5. Launch the Air Lift Towtal View app on your device.





iOS - Pair the HD Camera to the Mobile App

1. Press the plus “+” button (Fig. 3).
2. If you are already connected to the Towtal View Wi-Fi network, tap the “Connect” button (Fig. 4).
3. Tap on the camera with the Wi-Fi name (Fig. 5).
4. Figure 6 shows the mobile app’s Camera View screen.





Android - Pair the HD Camera to the Mobile App

1. Ensure that you are connected to Towtal_##### network.
2. Tap on the “Press to connect camera” button (Fig. 7).
3. Tap on the Towtal View Wi-Fi network (Fig. 8).
4. Tap on the camera with the Wi-Fi name (Fig. 9). Figure 10 shows the mobile app’s Camera View screen.









Mobile App User Interface

Night Vision Feature

(not shown in Fig. 11)

- Night vision activates automatically using infrared LED lights that also maintain color viewing.



Menu Walkthrough

1. The Figure 12 screen shows the camera with the Wi-Fi name that is paired to the mobile app.
2. Camera View is shown in Figure 13. Tap the Camera View icon in the lower left corner to access the camera (Fig. 11)
3. The Gallery is shown in Figure 14. Tap the Gallery icon in the lower right corner to open the Gallery (Fig. 11)
4. The Image Settings screen is shown in Figure 15. Tap the Image Settings icon in the upper right corner to access (Fig. 11).







Troubleshooting Connection Issues

Camera Interface is not connected to the phone (Fig. 16)

Solution

- Verify the device is connected to Towtal_ WiFi signal

Camera is not connected to the Camera Interface (Fig. 17)

Solutions

- Ensure the camera has power
- Pair the camera to the Camera Interface

Connectivity Alerts

If the app detects a connection issue between the device and the Camera Interface, it will alert the user (Fig. 18).

1. Check that the Camera Interface has power and is in range of the device.
2. Reconnect to the Towtal View Wi-Fi point.



Android Auto and Apple Carplay

Towtal View uses the Wi-Fi band of your mobile device. Due to this, a user cannot use WIRELESS Apple Carplay or Android Auto while connected to the camera. Using these services wired via USB is still functional (Fig. 19).

- The app will not interfere with Bluetooth calling or audio.
- GPS navigation and music streaming will be unaffected, provided that the device has a SIM card with a mobile data plan.
