

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

## **Inner Bracket**



**NOTE:** Your polyurethane bushing may vary in shape. Part number clways faces rear of vehicle.

- 1. Properly raise and support vehicle.
- 2. Remove torque arm bushing and bracket from car.
- 3. Remove rivets (A) by drilling with 7/32" drill bit or grind head of rivet off.
- 4. Remove rubber bushings including metal backing plates (B) from brackets.
- 5. Install inner bracket onto transmission.
- 6. Grease inside of bushing with supplied grease.
- 7. Install polyurethane bushing onto torque arm with part number facing rear of vehicle and position in inner bracket.
- 8. Install outer bracket.
- 9. Re-torque all fasteners to factory specifications.







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
