1) The outer metal shell of this bushing must be reused. DO NOT remove from swaybar eye.

2) Complete bushing assembly including outer metal shell must be removed before new urethane part can be installed. (Can be tapped out with a hammer) NOTE: DO NOT remove shell from front sway bar.

3) Rubber is bonded to the inside diameter of this bracket. With the bracket removed from the vehicle, heat must be applied to remove the rubber. Use caution when heating bracket. Do not overheat the aluminum.

These instructions for endlinks only. Sway bar bushings must be purchased separately.
