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It is recommended that if you are unfamiliar with this type of work that you refer to a qualified service center specializing in this type of work. It is also recommended that if you choose to do this work yourself that a factory service manual be obtained for the proper procedures pertaining to removal, replacement and proper torque specifications for your vehicle. This instruction set is intended as a guideline for the safe installation of Energy Suspension's Polyurethane.


STEP 1

Inspect engine torque mount for excessive wear and cracking. If the mount is severely damaged, ENERGY SUSPENSION recommends replacing with a new engine torque mount. Clean any dirt, grease, and excess rubber flashing that may be present inside the engine torque mount. NOTE: IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT THE INSIDE OF THE TORQUE MOUNT BE CLEAN AND FREE OF FLASH.

STEP 2

Install the polyurethane inserts into the torque mount. One insert will be installed on each side of the torque mount. If supplied in set, use the nylon retainers. Note: The square head of nylon tie may need to be trimmed to seat flush against insert. Refer to illustration for proper orientation of parts. Reassemble torque mount into engine compartment.

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
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
