Removal:

- 1. Toyota uses extra long bolts in all positions. For easy removal, wire brush the threads and spray with WD-40. See the "Mount Position Diagram" on page 2 for general location of body mounts.
- 2. Loosen all body mounting bolts, but only remove one side at a time. Some mounts are accessed from the inside of the cab. The plastic molding will need to be removed and the carpet pulled back to get to the black plastic caps covering the top of the body mount bolts. Remove bolts one side at a time with the bolts on the other side loosened only. (See Fig. 1 thru 4).

Important:

- 3. Only raise body high enough to remove & replace mounts. Always watch the fan shroud, brake lines, fuel lines, steering coupler and body panels around the bumpers for sufficient clearance when raising the body. When jacking the body use as long as possible 2X4 or 4X4 wood blocks in 2 places for maximum support. Never put jack pad directly on body panels. Be sure to shut all the doors when lifting the body.
- 4. Install the new upper body mounts and upper washers into positions 1,3 & 4. For position 2 & 5, install the adapter plates with small washers on top of frame perch using the factory bolts. Lower the body until it starts to touch the new washers, open the doors and install the long factory bolts. Lower the body all the way and install the new lower mounts, washers and factory nuts. Keep the nuts only finger tight until both sides are completely installed. Repeat on other side. (See Fig. 5 thru 8 for assembly sequence)

Note: When disassembling, note the quantity and positions of any shims that may have been inserted for body alignment. These shims will have to be reused to insure proper body alignment.

5. Torque all nuts & bolts to factory specs. Reinstall the black plastic plugs, carpet and plastic panels.

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
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


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
