

- that you have read and understand these instructions.

Removal of Stock System

- **1.** Apply penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers, and rubber insulators.
- **2.** Disconnect the exhaust valve electrical connection and tuck the plug up behind the inner fender liner. There is a small tab to press down to unlock the connector.

Refer to Figure 1.

3. Mark and cut the exhaust pipe at the dimple located ahead of the rear muffler.

4. Remove the factory rear muffler from the rubber insulators.

Installation of MBRP Performance Exhaust

- 1. It is easiest to loosely assemble the system before installing onto the car. Place the Cross-Over Pipe onto the Y-Pipe Assembly. Slide two 3.0" Clamps onto the Cross-Over Pipe along with the Driver-Side Tail Pipe. Place the 3.2" Band Clamp onto the Y-Pipe Assembly inlet. Refer to Figure 3 and Page 1.
- 2. Install the Y-Pipe Assembly Inlet onto the factory exhaust pipe. Refer to Figure 4.
- **3.** Rotate the **Y-Pipe Assembly** to insert the **Hanger** into the passenger-side factory insulator.

Refer to Figure 5.

4. Insert the **Driver-Side Tail Pipe Hanger** into the driver-side factory insulator.

Refer to Figure 6.

- **5.** Center the outlets in the fascia openings and snug, but do not completely tighten the **Clamps**.
- **6.** Install the **Tips**, and adjust to your liking, centered in the fascia openings. Center the passenger-side **Tip** first, by rotating the **Y-Pipe Assembly** on the factory exhaust pipe. Rotating the **Cross-Over Pipe** on the **Y-Pipe Assembly** adjusts the relative **Tip** height. Sliding the **Driver-Side Tail Pipe** on the **Cross-Over Pipe** will allow the driver-side **Tip** to be centered precisely. The joints are not intended to be bottomed out to allow for these adjustments. **Refer to Figures 7-9.**



10. Carefully align the system and tips. Align the edge of each band clamp with the edge of the joint it is connecting. Tighten all hardware and clamps, starting at the front and working rearward to secure the system. Check along the full length of the exhaust system to ensure there is adequate clearance for fuel lines, vent lines, brake lines, frame, bodywork, suspension and any wiring, etc. If there is any interference detected, relocate or adjust to provide adequate clearance. Ensure all clamp connections are secure and components are unable to rotate or slide. Band clamps require approximately 45 lb-ft (60 N-m) of torque. Verify clearances, system security and band clamp torque after 30-60 miles (50-100 km) of driving.
