

Removal of Stock System

1. Apply penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
2. Remove the 3 nuts and bolts at the flange connection and remove the OE muffler assembly from the vehicle. Repeat for both driver and passenger sides. Retain the OE gasket inserts and hardware as they will be reused.

Refer to Figure 1.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

1. Pre-Assemble the Passenger-Side exhaust assembly on the floor by first installing a **3" Band Clamp** onto the **Passenger-Side Tailpipe** before installing it onto the outlet of a **Muffler Assembly**. Adjust the **Muffler Assembly** and **Passenger-Side Tailpipe** as shown in Figure 3.

2. Install the Passenger Side assembly onto the vehicle by first sliding the hangers into the rubber isolators, followed with the installation of a OE gasket Insert. Secure the 3 bolt flange with the OE hardware previously removed.

Refer to Figure 4.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the Driver Side components.

4. Adjust the rotation of both **Tailpipes** so the hangers are positioned centered in the rubber isolators.

5. Adjust the system to provide clearance between all other under body components and hoses. Tighten all clamps once properly adjusted.
