

Instructions Rear Differential Bushings


- steel tube 25.4x12.2x52 x2

- steel tube 28.6x14.4x60 x1

- washer 45x12x2.5 x4

Rear bushing can be removed in car using a mechanical puller - refer page 2



· Lift vehicle evenly and safely support.


Never rely on a Jack only

Note - with an appropriate mechanical puller, bushings can be removed in-car. Alternatively, proceed to remove subframe from vehicle.

Careful not to compromise any brake lines when lowering sub-frame.

This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.

Rattle Gun



 Using a threaded/mechanical puller, 'pull' factory bushing out of sub-frame - remove steel outer shell.

Use quality nuts/bolt/washers - or have spares incase stripping occurs

Alternatively, a hole can be drilled into the rubber, then cut outer steel shell with Air-hack-saw. Careful to not damage sub-frame.


Spanner

 Once old bushing is removed, check sub-frame is clean with no burrs.





